

A- Full Admission (Unconditional Admission)

Applicants to all undergraduate programs should satisfy the below minimum requirements to get an unconditional admission offer letter:

B- Conditional Admission

Applicants to all undergraduate programs taught in English, must satisfy the minimum score in any of the international recognized English Proficiency Exams stipulated in table 1. Those who don't satisfy the English language condition by the time of admission will be offered a conditional admission offer letter and will need to complete the "English language Foundation Program" which will ensure that applicants will complete the first four levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), those levels are A1, A2, B1 and B2. By successfully completing the B2 level, applicant will have the proficiency of TOEFL ITP 500 or its equivalent.

Students will be able to enroll in no more than 12 C.H of specific general education courses during their study period at the program. Students will not be able to take any core/specialization courses before completing the four levels.

Students who are enrolled at the "English Language Foundation Program" and at any time during their study at the program fulfil the English language proficiency requirements through any of the recognized English Proficiency Exams stipulated in table 1, will be exempted from completing the remaining components of the program.

C- Probation Admission

Applicants to undergraduate programs who don't meet the minimum High School average as stipulated in Table 1, will be offered a probation admission offer letter, those students will enroll for not more than 12 C.H during their first semester at AUE, and will need to achieve a minimum semester GPA of 2.0 by the end of their first semester, otherwise, they will be dismissed from the program.

D- Provisional Admission

Applicants who don't submit one or more of the below admission documents, will be offered a provisional admission letter, and will need to submit the missing document before the end of their first semester at AUE:

- Attested copy of the High School Certificate
- Certificate of Equivalency from UAE Ministry of Education (for non-MOE and foreign certificates)
- Attestation of transferred transcripts from UAE Ministry of Education
- Valid copy of passport
- Valid copy of Emirates ID
- Certificate of Good Conduct

AUE Placement Tests

All applicants to undergraduate programs need to sit for asset of. placement tests upon admission, students who fail in any of the placement tests, will need to study a preparatory course in the relevant field of the placement test during their first semester, those preparatory courses are not included in the students' CGPA or the overall credit hours required for graduation.

The below table represent the placement tests categorized per academic program:

Admission Interview

All university applicants are required to attend a personal interview with a member of the college they wish to join. The purpose of the personal interview is to assess the student's level of proficiency in a variety of personal skills, as well as his knowledge of the program he wishes to enroll in, and to review the student's record of accomplishments during his previous educational years in terms of initiatives and extracurricular activities.

Exemption Criteria

Applicants who achieve specific thresholds in standardized tests, such as SAT Subject Tests, IB Diploma HL subjects, or equivalent qualifications, may qualify for exemptions in the relevant subjects. For further details, please refer to the table below.
